Help the Discovery Mountain Pathfinders find their way to Oshkosh in time for Camporee!

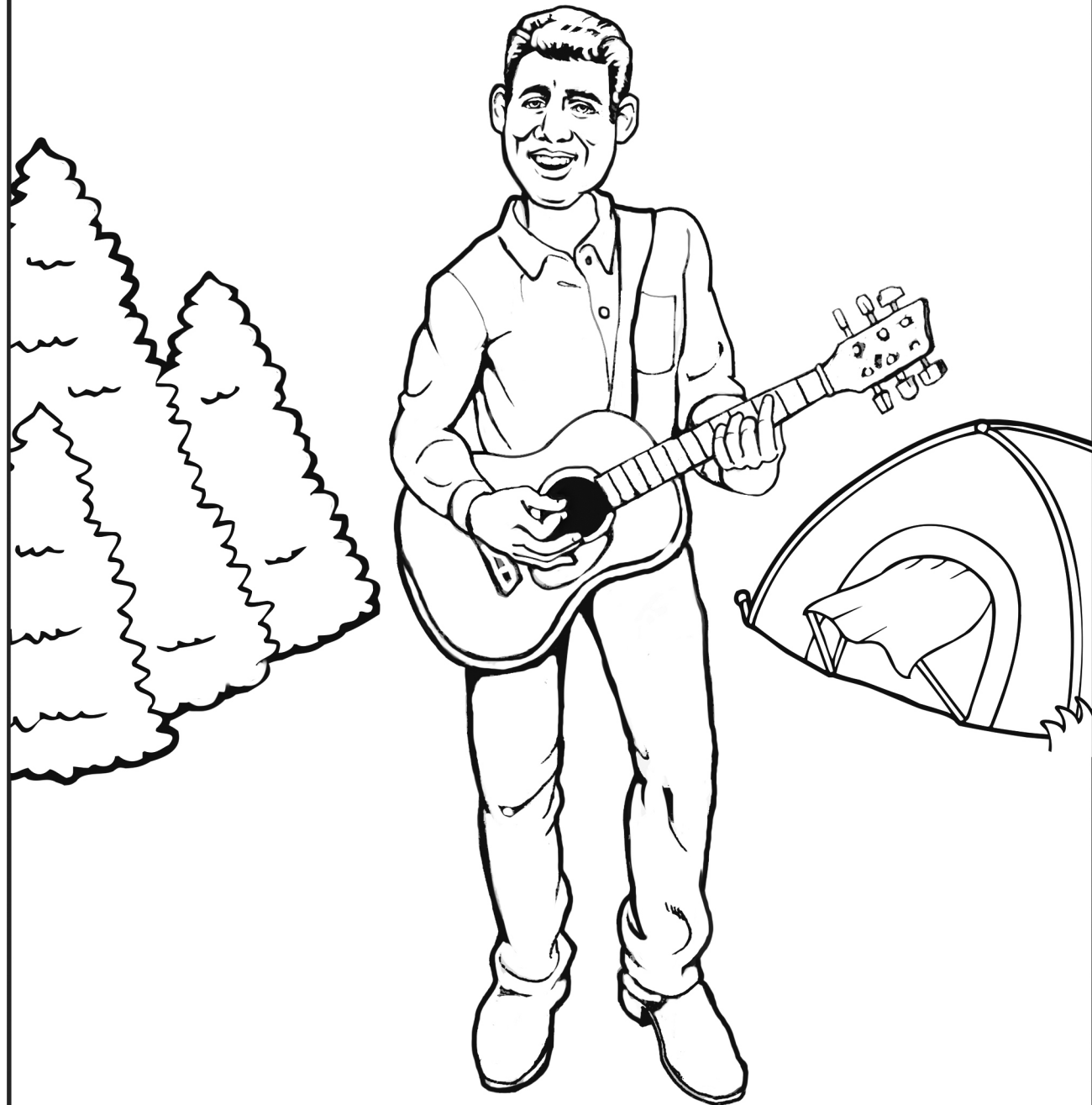

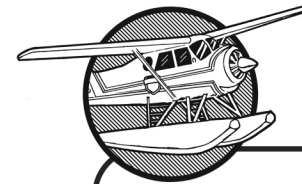

### EPISODE 3: “Brotherly Love”

The Pathfinders and their bus seem to keep having trouble! The Pathfinders from Argentina showed their faith by showing brotherly love for their fellow travelers to Oshkosh. There were also times, unfortunately, when brotherly love wasn’t shown.

- Owen tells Madison that he doesn’t believe Madison is a real wrangler or “cow boss” and hurts her feelings.
- Jamey and Natasha apologize for how they treated each other.

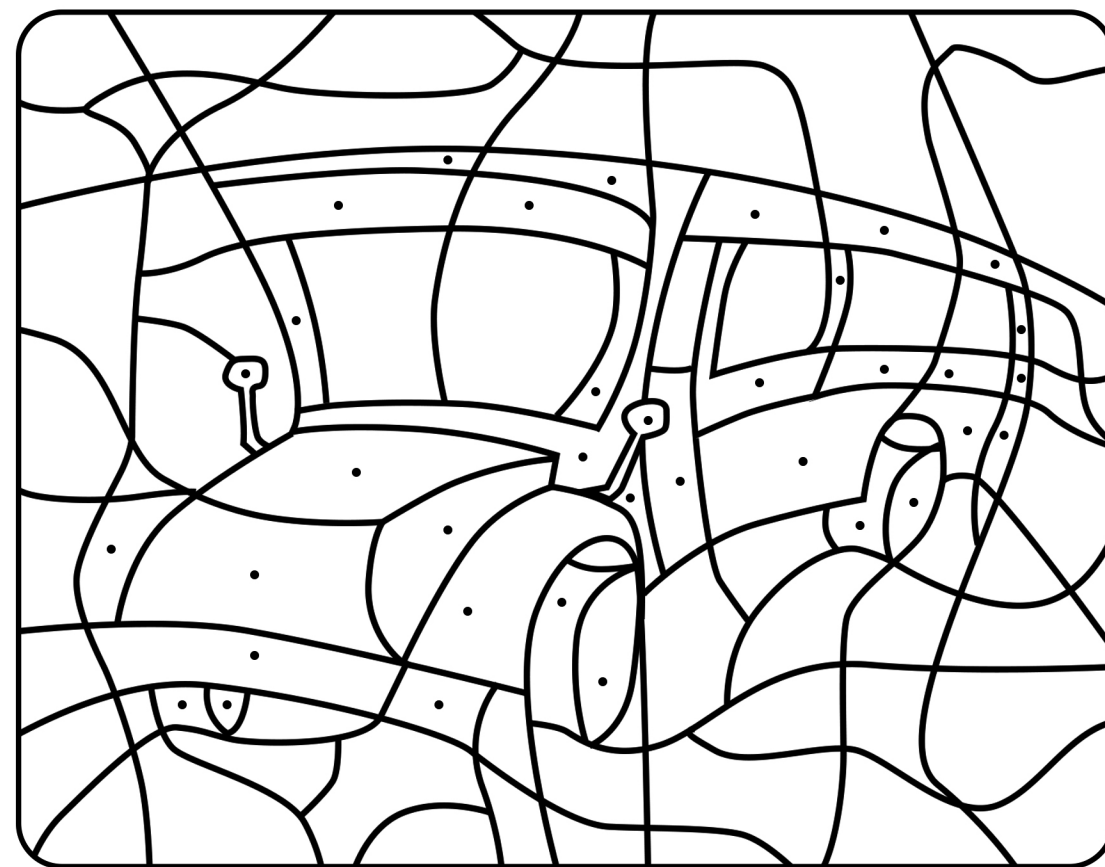


## EPISODE 4: "All Aboard!"

The picture below appears to be a rectangle. **Color in the spaces marked with a dot to discover the real picture!**

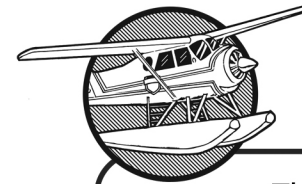

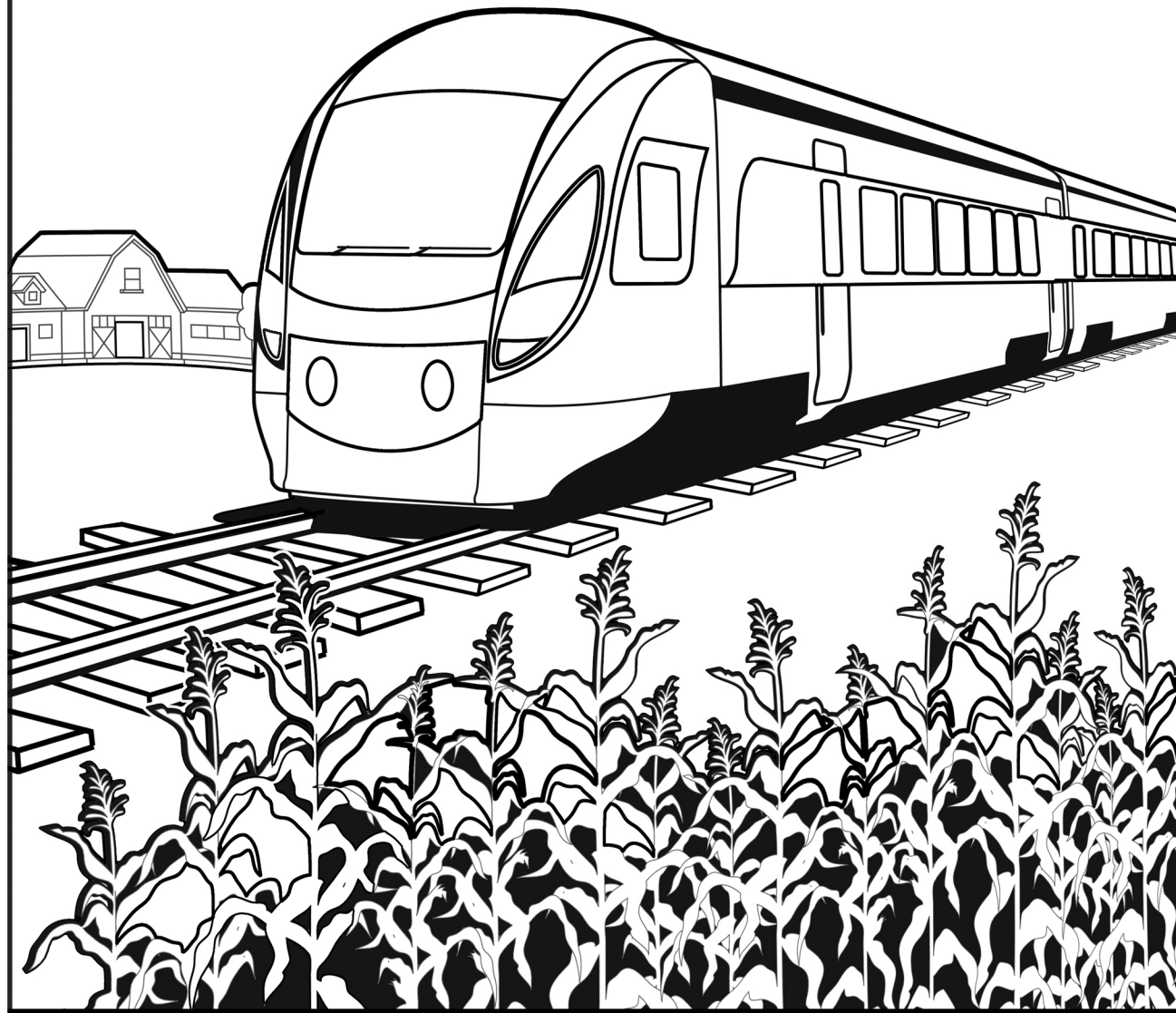

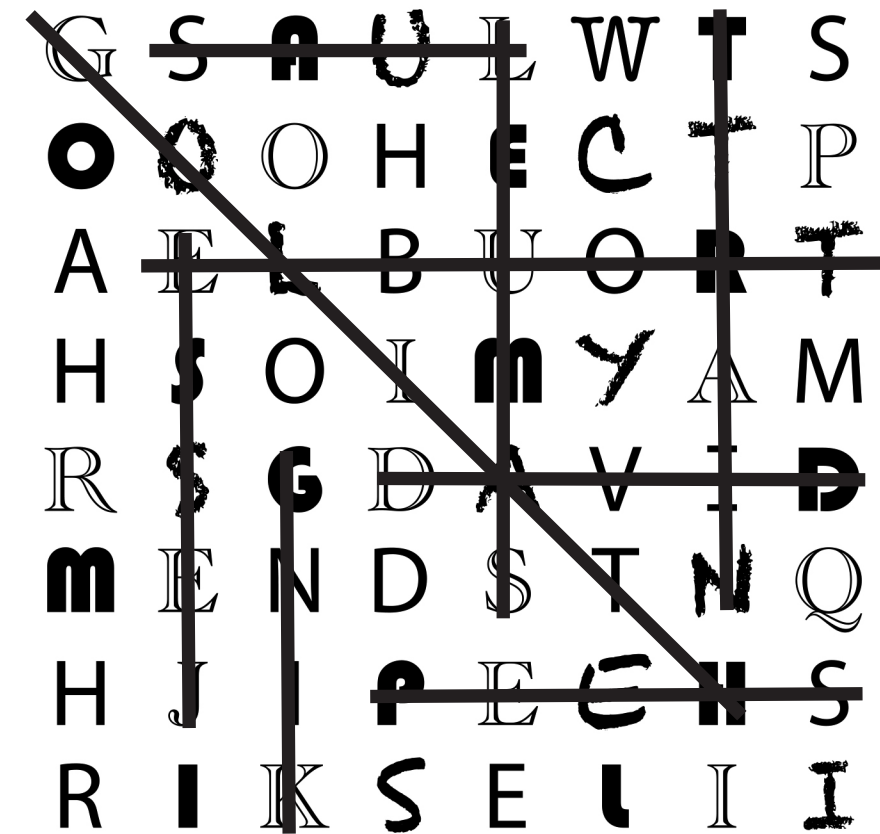


## EPISODE 5: "David and Goliath"

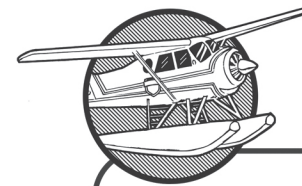

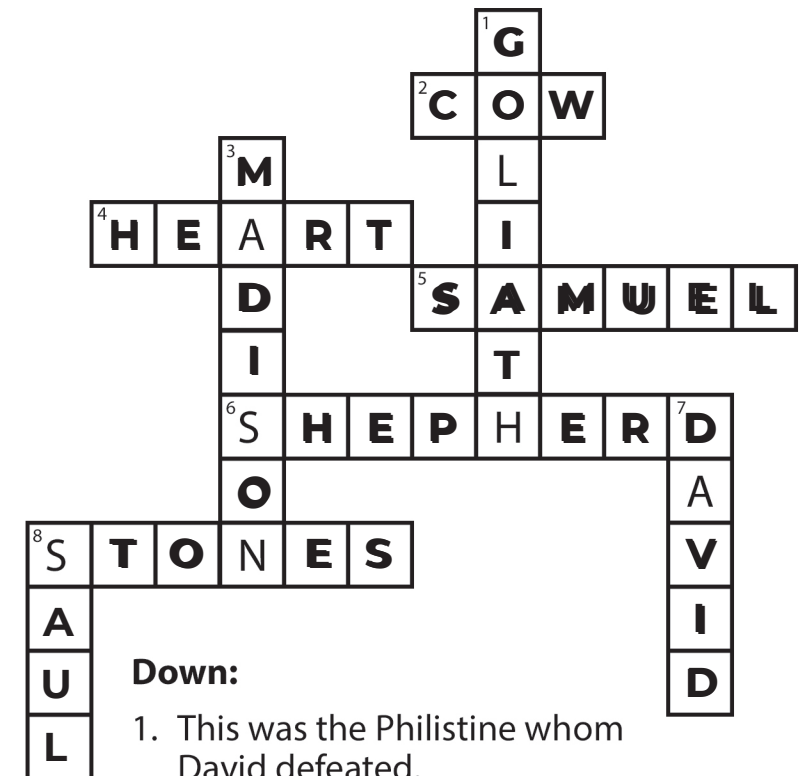
## EPISODE 5: “David and Goliath”

**In this crossword puzzle, fill in the details from the story.**

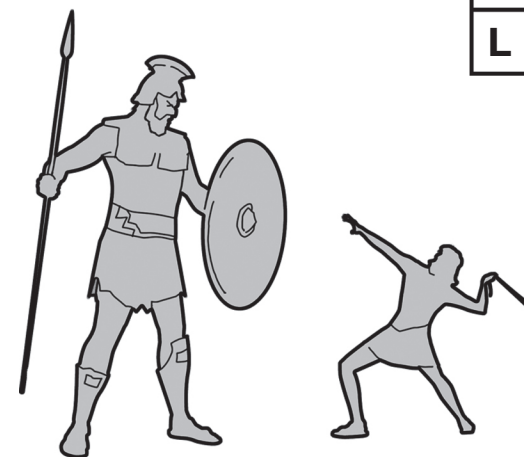

## EPISODE 6: “Chosen”

Mr. Gary hands the leadership of the Discovery Mountain Pathfinders over to Natasha, and they finally arrive together at Camporee! They exercise their faith by showing the traits of David to one another.

The characters in our Discovery Mountain story experienced many of the same things that the people in David’s time did. There are a lot of similarities. **Match what happens in Discovery Mountain with the real history from the Bible story.** The first one has been done for you.

Natasha was chosen to lead the Pathfinders because of her deep love for the children.

Madison is not a very big person, but she does extraordinary things as she wrangles a cow off the train tracks.

George Simon hints in an earlier episode that Natasha could be the next Pathfinder director.

Natasha throws Mr. Gary’s whistle in a metal trash can and goes with her own way of successfully leading the club.

David throws down King Saul’s armor and weapons and uses a sling and stones instead to successfully slay Goliath.

David was chosen by God to lead his people because of his deep love for God.

David is a small shepherd of sheep, but he goes on to do extraordinary things like lead God’s flock of people.

Samuel anoints David as a shepherd boy and tells him that he will rule God’s people someday.

God was with David and his people when he battled Goliath, and He’ll guide us during our difficult times, too!

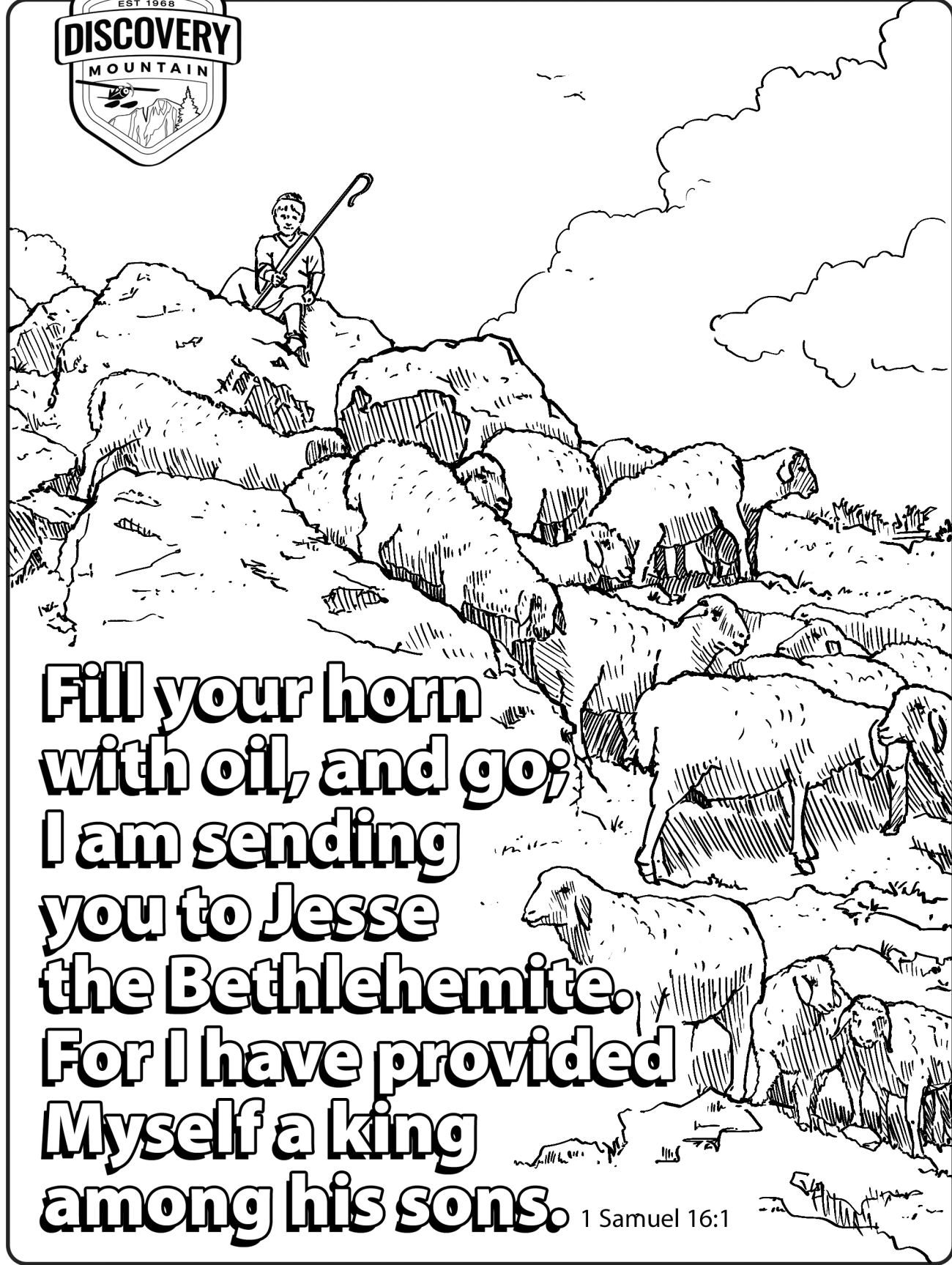

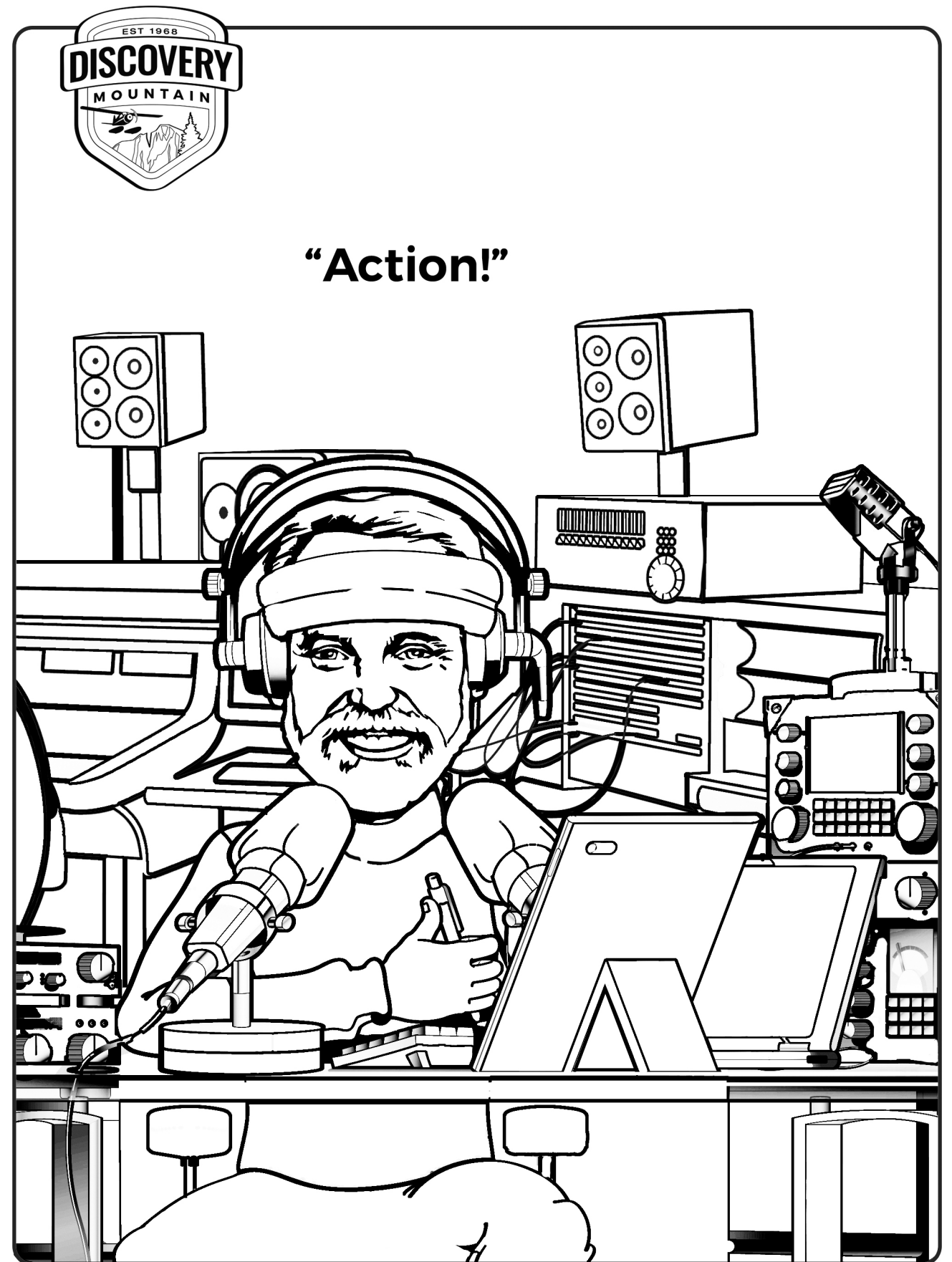

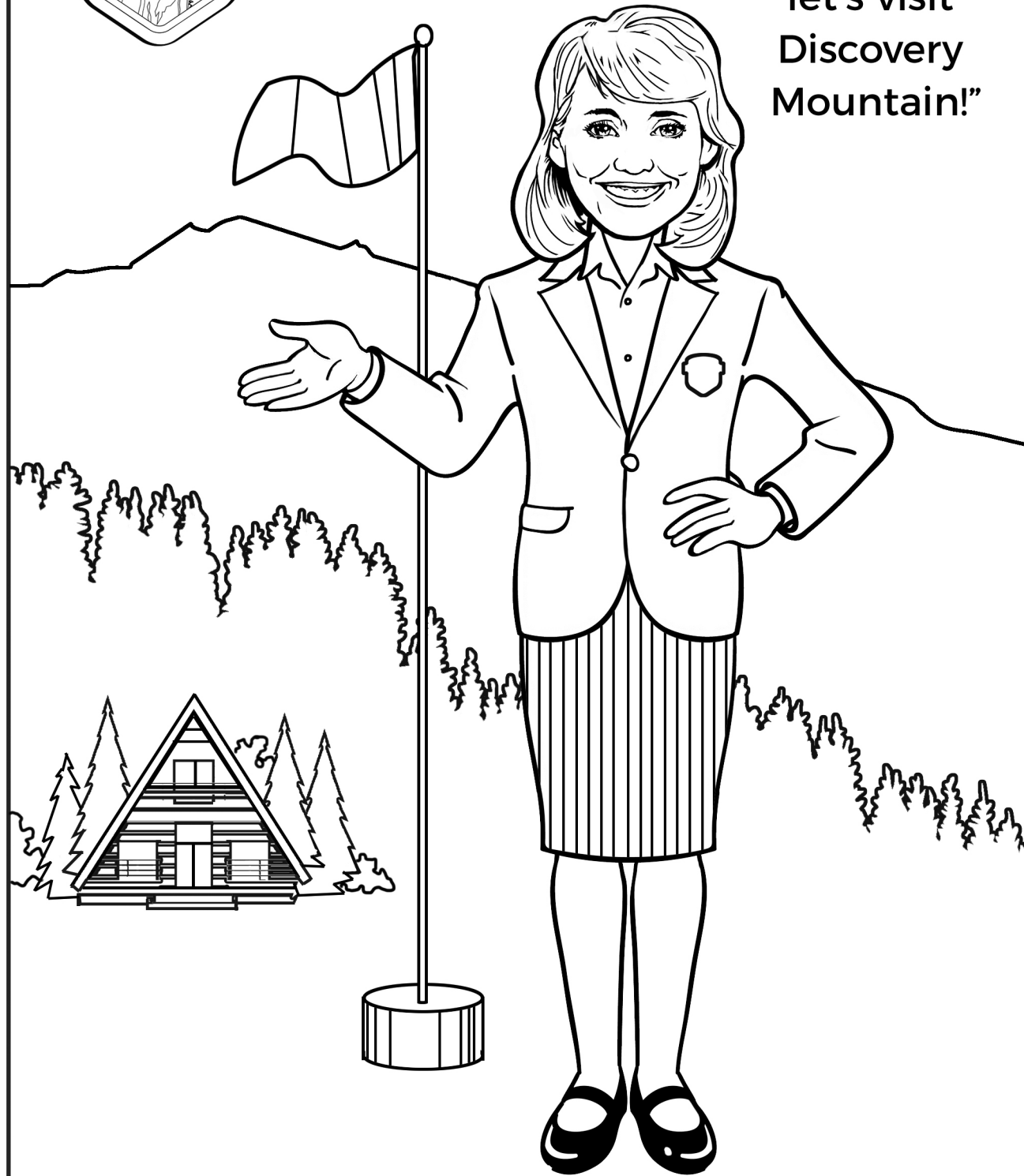
